Please accept my invitation to visit the blossoming Georgetown Cultural District and see for yourself. Whether you are a resident or a visitor to Georgetown, there are opportunities to be found year-round in music, art, theatre, history, and culture, and this Georgetown Arts & Culture Guide is the place to start your search.

What are the high points that no one should miss? To start with, the Georgetown Art Center, the Georgetown Palace Theatre, Grace Heritage Center, The Williamson Museum, and the Georgetown Public Library are all nestled around the Most Beautiful Town Square in Texas. The Square also is home to shops and galleries, wineries and restaurants with live music and delicious food. A visit to the Square to watch a play or to take in an art exhibit or a historical exhibit is a great way to spend an afternoon or evening.

Expanding out from the Square, in the summertime we have a classical music festival called Georgetown Festival of the Arts, and in the fall and spring the Georgetown Symphony Society brings us a symphony season. Southwestern University, a liberal arts university, offers outstanding concerts, plays, and art exhibits open to the public.

Despite our explosive growth, all of these options are either inside the Cultural District or just a five minute drive from it. Visit the pages of this Arts & Culture Guide to see how we are growing, and please search out the many avenues for inspiration in our fast-growing Cultural District.

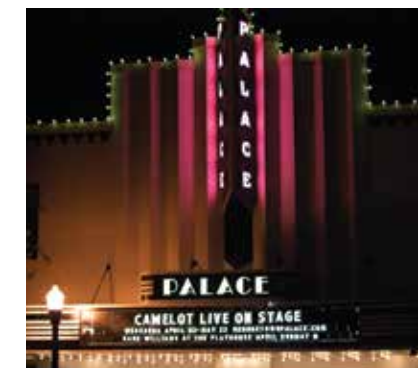

AN INSPIRED DESTINATION FOR ARTS & CULTURE

The comment heard most often after last year's issue of the Georgetown Arts & Culture Guide was published was an emphatic, "There is way more going on in Georgetown than I thought!"

The wide-ranging arts opportunities in town are inspiring. The Texas Commission on the Arts agrees that Georgetown has a lot going on, so they designated a 40-block area surrounding the Square as a state Cultural District—a special arts zone. Georgetown's Cultural District is one of only 28 cultural districts across the entire state, lending a level of distinction and recognition to the community.

Georgetown is also distinctive in that it is the fastest growing city over 50,000 people in the entire country. The cultural arts sector is taking off as a result of that population growth. Arts and culture organizers bring the architecture and history of the area to life, curate thought-provoking art exhibits and events, create magical theatre experiences, and organize concerts that inspire.



Georgetown's Cultural District overlaps the historic downtown Square and its many wonderful restaurants, wineries, galleries, and much more. It is the focal point for dedicated arts and culture organizers: the people who are the foundation of the vibrant arts community. The Square—the Most Beautiful Town Square in Texas—is at the center, lined with antique shops, restaurants, and cultural attractions. There are new and exciting things to do every year.

There may be way more going on in Georgetown and the Cultural District than you realized, too.



INSPIRED THEATRE

Georgetown enjoys wonderful live theatre performances in the local Georgetown Palace Theatre as well as in the two performing arts theatres at Southwestern University's Sarofim School of Fine Arts. Between the two, there are musicals, dramas, comedies, and more throughout the year.

Southwestern University's Sarofim School of Fine Arts has a Theatre Department that nurtures students' creativity in the classroom and brings it alive on the stage. From family-friendly to funny to provocative to original dramatic productions, the talented faculty, students, and guest artists who star in Southwestern's theatre productions are a gift to Georgetown residents and visitors.

The Georgetown Palace Theatre offers live theatre productions year-round. The quality of the acting, directing, and production earns impressive reviews. In addition to the main stage lineup, the Palace has put together fun-filled musical performances and non-musical plays that are sure to entertain at the Palace Playhouse, right across the street from the historic theatre. Between the Sarofim School of Fine Arts offerings at Southwestern University and the Palace Theatre productions, theatre in Georgetown is thriving, with high quality options for all tastes.

GEORGETOWN CULTURAL DISTRICT

INSPIRED MUSIC

People with a passion for chamber concerts, symphony performances, piano recitals, jazz on the downtown Square, folk in a local winery, '40s tunes in a restaurant, or rock 'n' roll in a bar will find something that suits them in Georgetown.

Opportunities to experience classical music are surprisingly frequent, and many performances feature world class performers. These include an annual Van Cliburn recital, featuring a finalist in the International Piano Competition, in addition to a season of six concerts spanning September to May held in the Klett Center for the Performing Arts.

Southwestern University offers the Sarofim Series of Music bringing in some of today's most sought after musicians. In addition there are multiple guest artist recitals, concerts, and faculty recitals, as well as performances by student groups: wind ensemble and orchestra, opera theatre, jazz ensemble, and chorale.

The Georgetown Festival of the Arts organizes a Classic Chamber Concert series and also creates a wonderful week of concerts, lectures, a film showing, and more each year, including a free concert in San Gabriel Park that is followed by fireworks.

Every month, there is a free concert at the Georgetown Public Library: Live Music at the Library is at 2 pm the third Sunday of each month and ranges from jazz bands to classical soloists and ensembles to folk, bluegrass, and world music.

Many of the city's wineries, restaurants and bars feature live music, as well. To find these events, visit the City's Entertainment Calendar at visitgeorgetown.com.

INSPIRED ART

Georgetown has public art around the Square, in parks, on Southwestern University's campus, at the public library, and elsewhere. There are several local art galleries, and visitors and residents find changing art exhibited in many restaurants and businesses, as well.

The Sarofim Art Gallery at Southwestern University features exhibits by professional and student artists. The gallery is always free and open to the public, with opening receptions and sometimes artist talks as well.

The Georgetown Art Center is just off the Square, the result of a renovation that transformed Georgetown's 124-year-old Firehouse Number 1 into the award-winning Georgetown Art Center. The art center offers residents and visitors year-round curated exhibits with a variety of mediums, artists, and styles. Each year, more than 100 different artists and more than 200 pieces are exhibited at the center, which welcomes up to 3,000 visitors each month. Every exhibit includes an artist reception that is free to the public.



ARTISTS DIRECTORY

Local artists participate in plein air painting events, enter their work in competitions, participate in exhibits near and far, attend or give artist talks and workshops at the Georgetown Art Center and elsewhere, and most importantly of all, they spend many hours making art in their studios and homes.

The City of Georgetown hosts an Artists Directory online to help the public and local artists connect.

The Georgetown Public Library has an exhibit area where artists show their work year-round, and local art organizations hold meetings and workshops in the library's meeting rooms. The library also hosts two state-level exhibits each year: the annual Texas Society of Sculptors summer show, and the Art Hop competition, which is held in partnership with the Georgetown Art Center.

The City of Georgetown sponsors a rotating Sculpture Tour in close collaboration with the Texas Society of Sculptors. The Sculpture Tour features works of art in three locations: Main Street between Seventh and Eighth streets, Georgetown Public Library, and Georgetown Recreation Center.

INSPIRED HISTORY AND CULTURE

Georgetown's history and architecture are fascinating, and there are many ways to enjoy them.

The rich story of this part of Central Texas is told by The Williamson Museum, and a visit to the museum begins outside on the sidewalk with the life-sized bronze of Robert McAlpin Williamson, or "Three Legged Willie," for whom the county was named. History lovers and families will enjoy a stop at the museum to see insightful exhibits with artifacts and information for a fascinating glimpse into the local past. The museum sponsors a rich mix of events and lectures, as well.

The Georgetown Heritage Society operates the Grace Heritage Center, and preserves and promotes Georgetown's heritage. The society hosts events such as the Holiday Home Tour in historic Georgetown and The Amazing Heritage Quest, a fun event for families and friends.

In addition to visiting the Williamson Museum and the Grace Heritage Center, residents and visitors enjoy the Downtown Walking Tour or Historic Homes Driving Tour, or seeing Historic Marker Sites and National Register Historic Districts in town. The architecture around the Square is fascinating, and the Georgetown Palace Theatre, an integral part of the downtown Square, merits a look too as an Art Deco movie house (renovated and in 2001 opened as a live community theatre venue).



INSPIRED EDUCATION

Arts education for children and teens is a priority in the Georgetown Independent School District's Fine Arts Department. The department includes Band, Choir, Orchestra, Dance, Theatre, and Visual Art. Classroom instruction as well as extra-curricular activities and UIL competition engage students in the arts.

The Palace Theatre's education program has been so successful that it has led to a \$2.5 million campaign to build a Children's Theatre and Education Center in the Cultural District.

The Georgetown Symphony Society supports the Vivace Youth Orchestra under the direction of Mary Powers and David Jennison. The orchestra is composed of high school level students from the Williamson County area who want to have a greater musical experience. The Society also presents a Musical Enrichment program for the fourth and fifth graders of Williamson County by presenting semiannual concerts for children.

Many other non-profit organizations and businesses support teaching and development for local artists of all ages in the performing arts and visual arts. (See listings in the Business Directory.)

Summer camps for art, theatre, and history take place every summer, as well, hosted by the Georgetown Art Center, the Georgetown Palace Theatre, and The Williamson Museum.



ARTS & CULTURE SUMMER CAMPS

Georgetown Art Center

Georgetown Art Center offers one of the best creative camps in the greater Austin area with themes such as Talk with the Animals, The Art of Anime, Girls Just Want to have Fun, and more. Learn watercolors, acrylics, colored pencils, graphite, oil pastels, pen & ink, etc. Last year over 1,000 kids and teens attended the art center's summer art programs. 2017 camps will run from early June til mid-August.

Georgetown Palace Theatre Summer Workshops

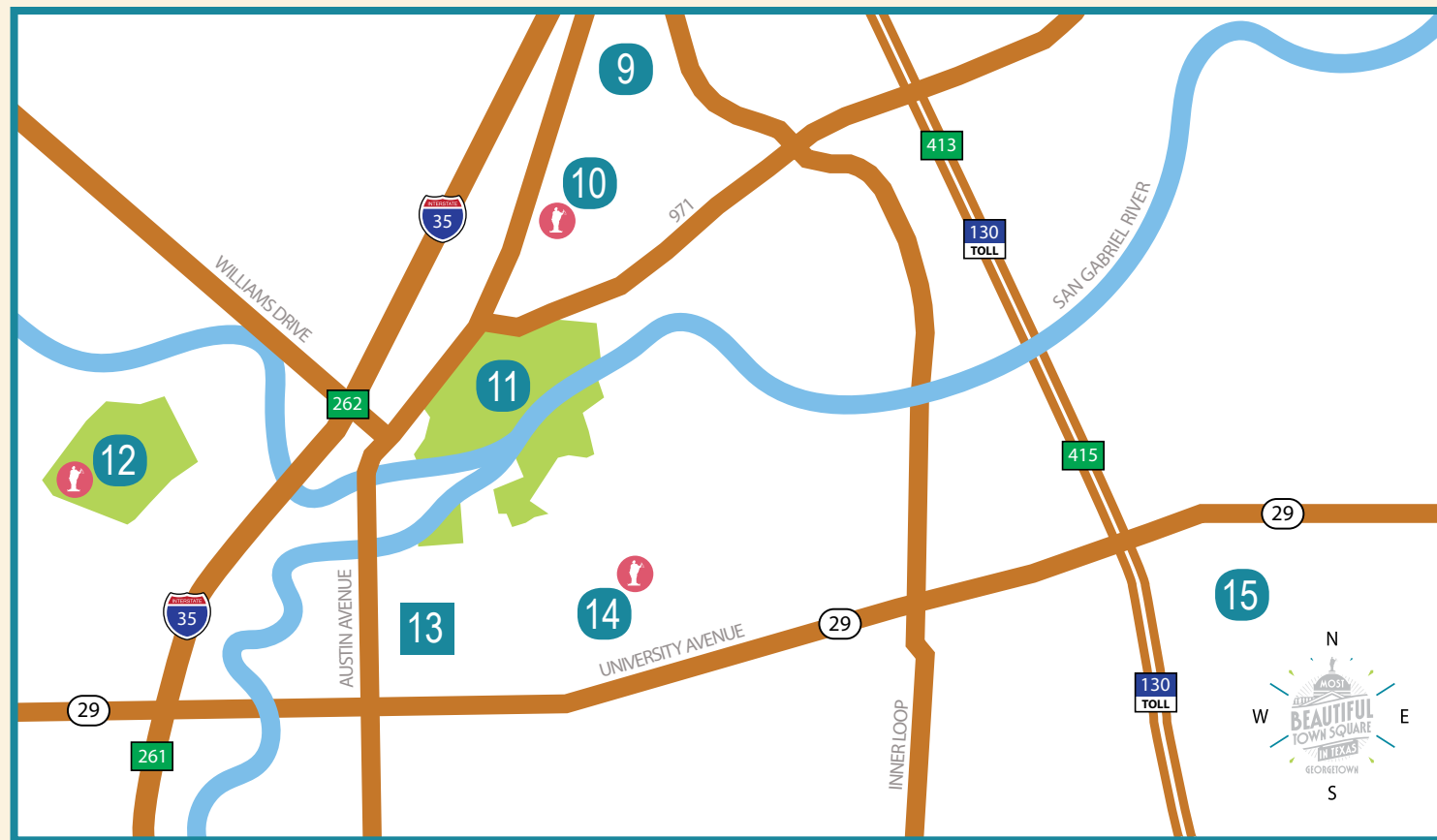

The Georgetown Palace Theatre is a model of a successful community theatre. The staff are dedicated to providing quality and affordable entertainment and educational opportunities in the performing arts. The Palace is home to a year-round season of frequently sold-out live theatre productions. The quality of the acting, directing, and production values of past shows has earned consistently impressive reviews.

The Palace's new season will include seven full productions. In addition to that main stage lineup, the theatre has put together fun-filled musical performances and non-musical plays that are sure to entertain.

History matters in Georgetown, and the Palace has held a place in the city's heart since 1926. Built in the downtown Square, it opened originally to show silent films. The theatre is the only Art Deco period building in Georgetown, and the marquee is original to the theatre. The former movie house was renovated and in 2001 opened as a live theatre venue.

The Palace's education program draws students from across Central Texas; it offers classes, workshops, and training programs for aspiring actors, dancers, and singers from four years old to adults, and is currently engaged in a \$2.5 million campaign to build a new Children's Theatre and Education Center in the Cultural District with a 200-seat flexible configuration theatre, dance studio, classrooms, and more. The Palace education program is staffed by a cast of teaching artists who have worked in high school drama departments, Central Texas theatres, and on Broadway.

The Georgetown Palace Theatre's performances and education program are a gem for residents and visitors alike to enjoy.

Performances are Fridays and Saturdays at 7:30 PM and Sundays at 2 PM unless otherwise noted. Palace Theatre productions do require a ticket.

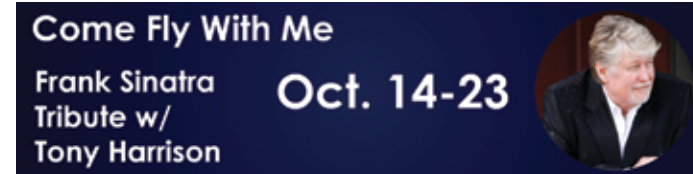

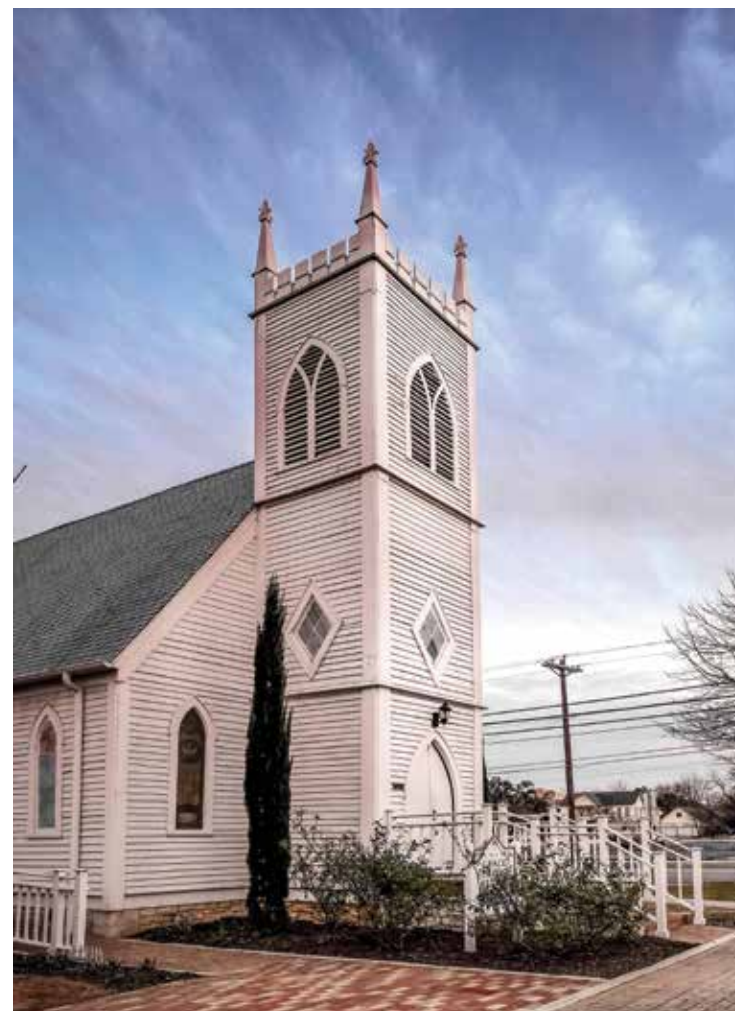

The Georgetown Heritage Society (GHS) preserves and promotes interest in Georgetown's heritage. GHS advocacy extends beyond saving old places; rather, it looks forward, as history, memory, and continuity contribute to sustainability, creativity, and economic growth.

The society operates the Grace Heritage Center, which is open Thursday and Friday 9 AM - 5 PM, Sunday 1 - 4 PM, and by appointment. The building served the congregation of Grace Episcopal Church from 1881 until 1991. Now in its second century of use and at its third location, it serves as the focal point of Founders Memorial Park and is one of many historic structures in Georgetown that have withstood the rigors of nature, growth, and change in the community. The church was rehabilitated through a unique partnership between the City of Georgetown and the GHS, which raised funds for and supervised the restoration project.



GHS hosts events that support and showcase Georgetown in a variety of ways. The Holiday Home Tour in historic Georgetown in December and The Amazing Heritage Quest in April promote the architecture and legend of historic Georgetown. Programs and activities engage the public in the past and the future.

The establishment of a Preservation Fund Grant Program assists residents and business owners in the renovation and rehabilitation of historic structures.

In 2017, GHS celebrates four decades of preserving the past for future generations. They invite you to join them as they tip their hat to Georgetown's history and heritage.

The Georgetown Art Center, housed in a historic building just off the downtown Square, became a centerpiece Cultural District institution in Georgetown in just three years of operation. This year the art center offers residents and visitors eight new curated exhibits with a changing mix of mediums, artists, and styles. Each year, more than 100 different artists and more than 200 pieces are exhibited at the center, which welcomes up to 3,000 visitors each month.

The rich story of this part of Central Texas is told by The Williamson Museum, and a visit to the museum begins outside on the sidewalk with the life-sized bronze of Robert McAlpin Williamson, or “Three Legged Willie,” for whom the county was named.

The museum opened to the public in 2003 in the 1912 Farmer’s State Bank Building. It features interactive exhibits to engage visitors of all ages. Monthly history-related programs are open to the public including The Salon, Hands on History and First Friday art exhibit openings. Tours of the 1911 historic Williamson County Courthouse are offered weekly and tell more stories of the county’s diverse past. Educational opportunities for families, teachers, and schools include a traveling trunk program, field trips, walking tours, Summer History Explorers Camp, primary source websites, and hands on activities throughout all exhibits.

The museum also hosts annual special events including an annual Cattleman’s Ball and a wide variety of tours downtown. From ghost tours to History Happy Hour, many include costumed interpreters sharing Georgetown’s story. Texas Independence Day is celebrated the first weekend in March with the “Three Legged Willie Race,” a fun run through historic neighborhoods, meeting early residents of the city along the way. The annual Marking History Tour in May celebrates Preservation Month, with historical markers coming to life during the free event. A tour of the city’s historic I.O.O.F. Cemetery each November allows visitors a unique opportunity to hear stories of the past. This year the museum welcomes new exhibits on Hispanic heritage and World War I.

Events include holiday concerts and performances, Veterans' Day concerts, pop shows, musicals, dance performances, and a jazz festival. Artwork by K-12 visual art students can be viewed each spring in a district-wide exhibit at the Georgetown Public library. Elementary schools frequently sponsor fine arts nights that feature musical programs and student artwork throughout the school year.

The Georgetown ISD Fine Arts Department includes band, choir, orchestra, dance, theatre, and visual art. Elementary students receive frequent and regular instruction in visual art and music. Secondary students study a wide range of disciplines within the fine arts and also participate in arts-related extracurricular activities and UIL competitions. At the high school level, additional courses in technical theatre, music theory, and music and media communications are also offered. AP-level courses in music theory as well as 2D and 3D visual art are offered.

Georgetown ISD utilizes two performing arts facilities: the 1,191-seat Klett Center for the Performing Arts located at the campus of Georgetown High School, and the East View Theatre, a 372-seat venue located at East View High School.

Parent and community volunteers play a critical role in the success of the diverse GISD Fine Arts programs. For more information, please contact the GISD Fine Arts office.

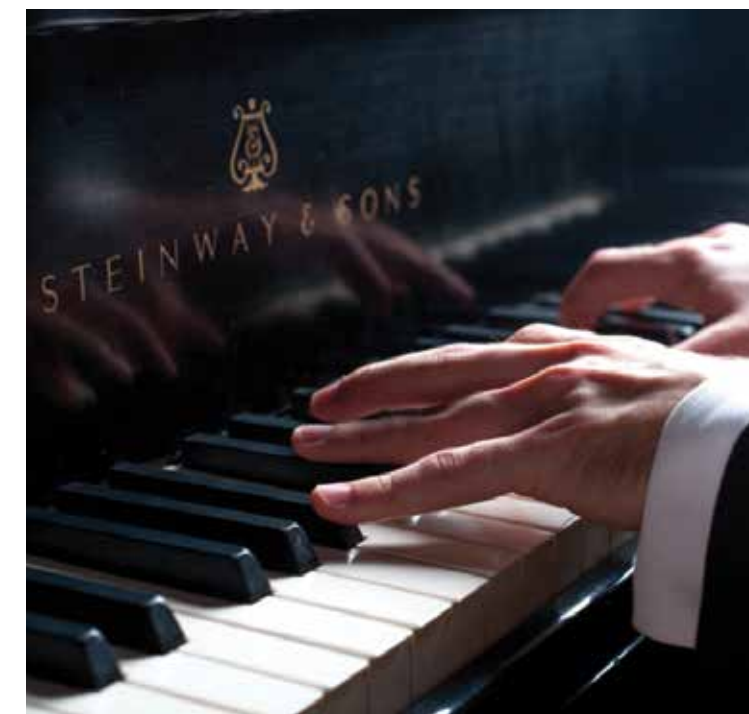

Georgetown Symphony Society is in its seventeenth season of bringing outstanding classical music to the Georgetown community. This year they will present three concerts by the Temple Symphony Orchestra conducted by Thomas Fairlie, and two by the Round Rock Symphony conducted by Stefan Sanders. The annual Van Cliburn concert will feature Vadym Khololdenko, the Gold Medal Finalist in the 2013 International Piano Competition.

Each year's performances are held in the spacious Klett Center for the Performing Arts, just a few minutes' drive from the Cultural District.

The Society supports the Vivace Youth Orchestra (VYO) under the direction of Mary Powers and David Jennison. The VYO is now in its sixth season and is composed of high school level students from the Williamson County area who want to have a greater musical experience. The Society also presents a Musical Enrichment program for the fourth and fifth graders of Williamson County by presenting semiannual concerts for children. These concerts introduce children to "the concert experience" and allow them to become more familiar with a variety of musical instruments.

The Society is dedicated to keeping classical music at the center of Georgetown culture.

Georgetown Festival of the Arts, now in its thirteenth year, presents an exciting annual event that includes multiple instrumental and vocal concerts, lectures, a film related to the festival's theme, a performance in San Gabriel Park by high school musicians followed by a fireworks display, and a final concert featuring a large choral work. The 2017 festival will take place May 27-June 4, and the festival's theme and title will be announced by organizers in October 2016.

Locations for festival events include Southwestern University, the Georgetown Palace Theatre, City Lights Theatre, and other performance spaces around Georgetown. Some years there is a related music event for children at the Georgetown Public Library.

Performers in the festival have included soloists and chamber musicians who appear in concert across the U.S. and throughout the world. In addition, lectures are offered by musicologists and experts on each year's featured composers.

In addition to the festival itself, the Georgetown Festival of the Arts offers a series of intimate Classic Chamber Concerts during the year. This season's chamber concert titles are "French Impressions," "Middle European Magic," and "American Idols."

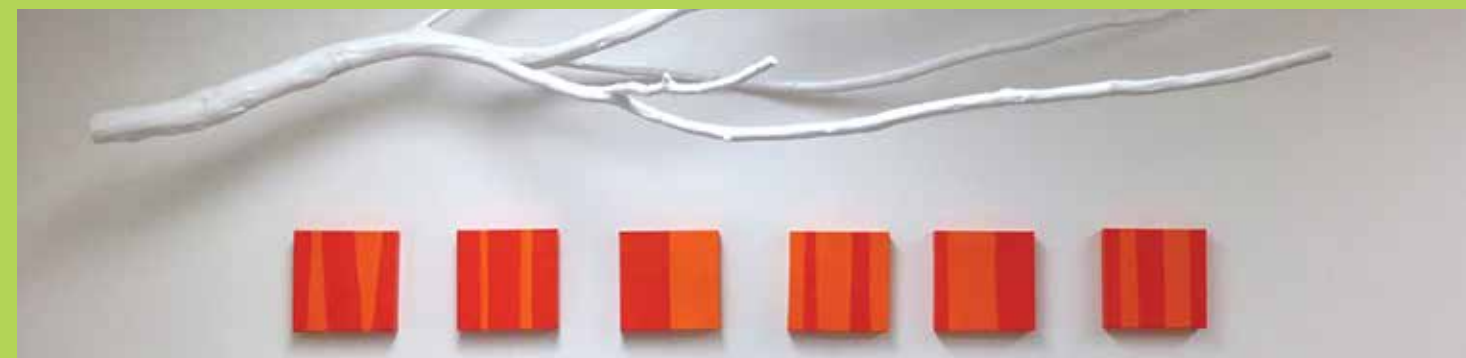
