





Ten years ago, the Texas legislature authorized the Texas Commission on the Arts to designate Cultural Districts—special arts zones—in cities where intentional arts-related development is occurring. Georgetown's Cultural District was approved by the commission in 2013. It is one of only 26 such districts across the state, lending a level of distinction and recognition to our arts community that we are very proud of.

We are also distinctive in that Georgetown is the second-fastest growing city in the country, according to the U.S. Census Bureau. Our cultural arts sector is blooming as a result of that population growth. Arts and culture organizers in town bring the architecture and history of our area to life, curate thought-provoking exhibits and events, create magical theatre experiences, and organize concerts that transport the listener.

Georgetown's Cultural District overlaps our historic downtown Square and its many wonderful restaurants, wineries, galleries, and much more. It is the locus for dedicated arts and culture organizers: the people who are the roots of our vibrant arts community.

Take advantage of the opportunities here, and visit our Cultural District anchors: the Georgetown Art Center, the Georgetown Palace Theatre, The Williamson Museum, the Georgetown Public Library, and Grace Heritage Center. Attend the concert season hosted by Georgetown Symphony Society and come to our annual Festival of the Arts. Be sure not to miss Southwestern University's Sarofim School of Fine Arts for outstanding theatre, concerts, and art exhibits.

The Georgetown Palace Theatre is a model among successful community theatres. The staff are dedicated to providing quality and affordable entertainment and educational opportunities in the performing arts. The Palace is home to a year-round season of frequently sold-out live theatre productions. The quality of the acting, directing, and production values of past shows has earned consistently impressive reviews.

The Palace's 2015-2016 season will include eight full productions. In addition to the main stage lineup, the theatre has put together exciting additional events: fun-filled dinner theatre, cabaret nights, and non-musical plays that are sure to entertain.

History matters in Georgetown, and the Palace has held a place in the city's heart since 1926. Built in the downtown Square, it opened originally to show silent films. The theatre is the only Art Deco period building in Georgetown, and the marquee is original to the theatre. The former movie house was renovated and in 2001 opened as a live theatre venue; the Palace now offers an exceptional theatrical experience for theatre-goers.

The Palace's education program draws students from across Central Texas; it offers classes, workshops, and training programs for aspiring actors, dancers, and singers from four years old to adults. The Palace education program is staffed by a star studded cast of teaching artists with a wide range of experiences and qualifications, including education at Suilliard, Middlebury College, Trinity University, and the University of Texas, and work experience from high school drama departments to Central Texas theatres to Broadway.

Children receive an experience like no other that introduces beginning theatre concepts and encourages self-confidence, cognitive skills, and gross motor skill development. The Palace also offers classes for children with special needs. Youth and teens benefit from workshops on the fundamentals of acting, improvisation, and musical theatre. They learn to work as a team, solve problems together, and develop active listening skills.

## SAROFIM SCHOOL OF FINE ARTS

Southwestern University's Sarofim School of Fine Arts (SSFA) has a lot to offer Georgetown's visiting and resident arts aficionados. The university supports world-class programs in art and art history, music, and theatre. The SSFA is housed in the Alma Thomas Theater. The three-story Fine Arts Center contains the Fine Arts Gallery as well as two theatres: the concert and performance venue the Alma Thomas Theater, and the intimate Jones Theater.

Art exhibitions on campus are remarkable. Throughout the academic year, the Fine Arts Gallery presents art exhibitions by nationally and internationally exhibited artists as part of the nationally ranked program offered by the Art and Art History Department. In addition, each year there are several student exhibitions. Regular visiting artist presentations and lectures by art historians are free and open to the public, as are artist receptions, gallery talks, and other special events.

Concerts on campus are wonderful, and attending them is easy, with convenient parking on campus. Dedicated to providing a robust and rigorous approach to the field of musical study and performance, the university's Music Department offers a variety of concerts and recitals by students, faculty, and guest performers throughout the academic year. These performances are all open to the public. Southwestern University attracts strong and dedicated students, and the university's music majors continue to be accepted into top music graduate programs.

Plays and musicals on campus are excellent, supported behind the scenes by fine technical facilities.







The university's Theatre Department offers a range of performances each year that are open to the public for a moderate admission charge. There are always four mainstage productions, including one musical theatre production. The 2015-16 mainstage season includes *The Fantasticks, The Importance of Being Earnest, A Night of Tennessee Williams, and Dead Man Walking.* In addition, students produce their own performance projects throughout the academic year in the department's Blackbox series.

The SSFA offerings at Southwestern are at the core of arts and culture in Georgetown. Whether your interest is art, music, or theatre, there will be something on this beautiful liberal arts college campus for you.

The Georgetown Public Library is a center for arts and culture in Georgetown, with offerings in art, music, history, architecture, and more.

Artists exhibit their work in the second floor gallery space, and local art organizations meet in the library's meeting rooms. The library hosts the annual Texas Society of Sculptors summer show and serves as an Art Hop location each fall. In addition to paintings, photographs, drawings, prints, and sculptures inside the building, sculpture exhibits are found outside the building, too.

The Live Music at the Library series brings monthly concerts to the first-floor lobby, and music can be heard throughout the building. Musical genres span a wide range: classical, bluegrass, jazz, folk, country, Latin, pop, and world music. The concerts transform the library into a concert venue with books—and sometimes dancing, too. No tickets or reservations are required; visitors just come have a seat and enjoy the music. The Live Music in the Library series is a gift of the Friends of the Georgetown Public Library. The Friends group also runs the library's used book store, Second-Hand Prose.

The Georgetown Public Library's dedicated staff members create a community experience that extends beyond the traditional, but the library collection does include over 110,000 printed books, e-books, digital and printed magazines and newspapers, CD's, DVD's, and more...the library even checks out bicycles and cake pans! There are also select historical records relating to local architecture, history, and genealogy, and reference services to help patrons find what they need.

The lively children's room has a wide variety of books and plenty of open floor space for storytime. The librarians pack the calendar with educational and entertaining programming for children of all ages. The first floor also offers a teen spot with video games, books, media, and comfy places to chill out.

One favorite library gathering place for people of all ages is the Red Poppy Coffee Co., a great place for a healthy lunch or a friendly conversation. The library offers plenty of study tables and free wi-fi, meeting space, public computers, and for those who can't make it to the library there is the WOW!mobile, a bookmobile that brings library adult and children's material out into the community.



# WILLIAMSON MUSEUM

The rich story of this part of Central Texas is told by The Williamson Museum, and a visit to the museum begins outside on the sidewalk with the life-sized bronze of Robert McAlpin Williamson, or "Three-Legged Willie." History lovers and families will enjoy a stop at the museum, which preserves the unique stories of Williamson County for present and future generations and promotes the culture and heritage of the county through education, preservation, acquisition and exhibition. The insightful exhibits and artifacts offer and interpret first-hand historical information and provide a fascinating glimpse into the local past. The museum educates, entertains, and enlightens residents and visitors alike.

The museum, established in 1997, features interactive exhibits to engage visitors of all ages, and monthly history-related programs open to the public including The Salon, Hands on History, and First Friday offerings. Tours of the 1911 historic Williamson County Courthouse are offered weekly and tell the story of the county's diverse past. Educational opportunities for families, teachers, and schools include the Hands on History and Traveling Trunk programs, tours, field trips, a Summer History Explorers Camp, special events, interactive primary sources through "WWII Comes to Williamson County."

The museum also hosts annual special events including an annual Cattleman's Ball and a Civil War Ball, and the Chisolm Trail Day event in San Gabriel Park. At Chisolm Trail Day, kids young and old can get up close and personal with a Texas hero and learn about the great cattle drives of the late 1800's. This half-day event features historical re-enactments, real cooking chuck wagons, live music, interactive stations, and culminates with a real cattle drive down a portion of the original Chisolm Trail. These are a fraction of the lively events that the museum organizes to bring history to life. Stop in and explore Georgetown's long and storied history.

Georgetown Festival of the Arts, now in its twelfth year, presents an exciting annual event that includes multiple concerts, lectures, a film related to the festival's theme, a performance in San Gabriel Park by high school musicians followed by fireworks, and a final concert featuring a large choral work performed by the San Gabriel Chorale. "Fire and Ice: A Festival of Music by Grieg, Sibelius, Nielsen and other Nordic Masters," will take place June 1-5, 2016. Locations include Southwestern University, the Palace Theatre, and City Lights Theatre. Frequently there is a related concert for children at the Georgetown Public Library, as well.

In addition to the festival itself, the Georgetown Festival of the Arts sponsors, along with the Round Rock Symphony, a series of three intimate Classic Chamber Concerts throughout the year.

Georgetown Symphony Society is in its sixteenth season of bringing outstanding classical concerts to town.

This year they present guest soloists performing works by Mozart, Bach, and Strauss. The season will include four concerts by the Temple Symphony Orchestra, conducted by Thomas Fairlie, and two by the Round Rock Symphony, conducted by Stefan Sanders. The annual Van Cliburn Concert features Nikita Mndoyants, pictured above, a finalist in the 2013 International Piano Competition.

Again this season the wonderful Vivace Youth Orchestras will perform under the direction of JD Janda and Mary Powers, and the society will offer a Musical Enrichment program with semiannual concerts to let children learn a little about what makes music wonderful.

# GEORGETOWN HERITAGE SOCIETY

The Georgetown Heritage Society's mission is to preserve and promote interest in Georgetown's heritage its historic buildings and sites and the people associated with them, as well as the documents, pictures, and other records relating to them. Its home base is the City-owned Grace Heritage Center, which is an example of a community preserving its architectural landmarks for adaptive re-use. The circa 1881 Carpenter Gothic chapel offers a distinctively gracious venue for weddings, meetings and special events, and is open to the public.

Today the society works to fulfill its mission in a variety of ways; they organize an annual Holiday Home Tour, featuring historic homes decorated for the holidays. Proceeds from the tour support other society initiatives including new Preservation Fund program, informative programs and educational publications. The charge of the Society continues to expand to meet responsibly the growth and needs of the community – ever mindful of preserving the past for future generations.



The Georgetown Art Center is emerging as a centerpiece of arts and culture in Georgetown and drawing attention from across the state. Each year, more than 100 different artists and more than 200 pieces are exhibited at the center, which welcomes almost 3,000 visitors each month.


The center's second exhibit season was extremely successful, and it is focused on maintaining and raising the quality bar. To that end, a busy and creative 2015-2016 season is up and running, with nine new curated exhibits and a changing mix of mediums, artists, and styles supported by complementary events.

Every exhibit includes an Artist Reception that is free to the public. These evening events are an opportunity to view the exhibit and talk to the artists and other arts supporters. The center also organizes ticketed evening events for more intimate conversations.

Education is an important focus of the center, which has an attached studio. Artist talks, a Visiting Artist Workshop Series, special topic workshops for children, open studio sessions, and lectures foster art skills and abilities in the community. The art center has a partnership with Cordovan Art School, which manages weekly skill building art classes and children's Summer Camp, and a community outreach program benefits local children and offers scholarships for summer camp, classes, and workshops.

The art center is housed in a historic building just off the downtown Square. The 2013 renovation of Georgetown's 123-year-old Firehouse Number 1 transformed it into the award-winning Georgetown Art Center. The building is owned by the City of Georgetown, and the art center is run by a nonprofit board, Georgetown Art Works. The center is staffed by dedicated volunteers who work 10,000 volunteer hours annually. The center is financially supported by membership fees, grants, and donations.

Thought-provoking exhibits and access to artists and art education are the foundation of the Georgetown Art Center, where residents and visitors experience and engage with art.

• Baron's intricate sculptural caricatures are satiric and fantastic. He places his work in the surrealist and visionary art movements. His process is intuitive, with archetypal and anthropomorphic imagery. Baron was born in Chicago in 1941 and raised in El Paso, Texas on the Mexican border. He has sculpted for some 35 years and has created more than 200 narrative bronze and cast stone figures. His recently published monograph on his sculpture is entitled "Gods for Future Religions."

Whether your passion is chamber concerts, symphony performances, piano recitals, jazz on the downtown Square, folk in a local winery, '40s tunes in a restaurant, or rock in a bar, there is something in Georgetown. Finding our venues is easy, and parking is free; many times, the events themselves are free, as well.

Opportunities to experience classical music are surprisingly frequent, and many performances feature world class performers. These include the Georgetown Symphony Society's annual Van Cliburn recital, this year featuring Cliburn International Competition finalist Nikita Mndoyants. The society also brings the Round Rock Symphony, directed by Stefan Sanders, and the Temple Symphony Orchestra, directed by Thomas Fairlie, to our Klett Center for the Performing Arts for a season of six concerts spanning September to May. Southwestern University holds multiple guest artist recitals and concerts and faculty recitals, as well as performances by student wind ensemble and orchestra, opera theatre, and chorale.

The Georgetown Festival of the Arts organizes a Classic Chamber Concert series and also creates a wonderful week of concerts, lectures, a film showing, and more each year, including a free concert in San Gabriel Park that is followed by fireworks. The theme for the June 2016 festival will be "Fire and Ice: A Festival of Music by Grieg, Sibelius, Nielsen and Other Nordic Masters."

In Georgetown, free concerts are a regular occurrence, so you can be spontaneous and frugal but still enjoy excellent performances of varied kinds of music. Southwestern University's concerts are all free, and enjoying a concert on the beautiful campus is a great way to spend an evening. Southwestern's ensembles include those listed above as well as a jazz band that really cooks. And every month, there is a free concert at the Georgetown Public Library: Live Music at the Library is at 2 pm the third Sunday of each month and ranges from jazz bands to classical soloists and ensembles to folk, bluegrass, and world music.
